ROCKY ROMANO raced in midpack, broke his inside line early turn but was hustled five-wide late turn his rider with one hand in the mane and his right hand holding the good line, continued gamely through the stretch and got up late under a drive. HARD TO FIND pressed then stalked the pace, bid upper stretch, dueled and just bested his rival but was passed in deep stretch. YES THIS IS IT set a pressured pace, vied into the turn and drove to a sole lead, was caught upper stretch, dueled and gave way grudgingly in the late stages. DIXIE TROOP pressed the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. STOLICHO settled in midpack, saved ground on the turn, angled out in the stretch and finished gamely. DOUBLE DOUBLE

closed up and forced the pace late backstretch, failed with a bid into the turn, chased four-wide then evened out in the stretch. VIGILARE, off the early pace, chased from midpack on the turn, was blocked at the top of the stretch then tendered a mild rally. POLITICAL ERA settled in midpack, was hustled along the rail late turn then evened out in the late stages. DISCREET KID raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. B VEXED, away slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn but failed to menace. STAGE SURVIVAL, in range early, backed away five-wide late turn then lacked a closing response. ASYMMETRIC, off slowly, moved up to duel late backstretch but backed away early turn, chased to the stretch and tired. BANKER LARRY, away alertly, quickly settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response.
