Footnotes

MORNING PRAYERS stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn, bid a furlong out and drove clear. PRETTY PRISSY, well back early, came four-wide through the turn and rallied willingly. LA GRAN RUBY raced midpack, chased between foes late turn then evened out. SPEEDSTORM stalked, chased three-wide on the turn and was all out in the stretch. PAULA MCCARTNEY stalked the pace, chased on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. BRAHMS AFFAIR raced off the pace, raced three-wide on the turn then rallied mildly. TEJANO THE QUEEN, off slowly, was well back early, saved ground, never threatened. TRUTH TAKES TIME trailed early and passed tiring horses in the stretch. SALTY PRINCESS led early, set a reserved pace, yielded near the 1/8 pole and tired. ON TIME DELIVERY stalked from the rail then tired in the stretch. HEAVENLY BREEZE was hustled from midpack on the backstretch but faded steadily.
