Weight: Three-Year-Olds 119 lbs., Older 124 lbs. Winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 three times at a mile or over in 2007, additional 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice at a mile or over in 2007 allowed 3 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 once at a mile or over in 2007, 5 lbs.; Of \$52,740 at a mile or over in 2007, 7 lbs. (Maiden or claiming races not considered) (No Canadian Bred Allowance) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry by a non-refundable fee of \$3,500 which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$15,150 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Closed Wednesday, October 24, 2007 with 17 nominations. Dancing Band supplemented.

LIKE A GEM showed brief speed, was headed and stalked the pace, pressured the leader late backstretch, took command early turn, set a pressured pace three then four-wide to the stretch and held off a determined I'M IN LOVE through the stretch. I'M IN LOVE, well back early, closed five-wide on the far turn, challenged late turn, was all out through the stretch but couldn't get by. TELL IT AS IT IS raced off the pace, angled two-wide to four-wide late turn, cut back inside upper stretch, finished determinedly then hung late. WOW ME FREE, unhurried along the rail, was hustled through the far turn, angled three-wide late turn and finished gamely. RUSSIAN ROSIE (IRE), well back early, was hustled four then five-wide on the far turn and rallied to no avail. YOUSAIDIDO

raced off the pace, came three then four-wide through the far turn, was hustled into the stretch then evened out. SERENADING led into the first turn, set a pressured pace, was headed entering the far turn, rebid at the top of the stretch but could not sustain the bid and tired. MONASHEE had brief speed from the gate, stalked from the rail, was hustled on the far turn, was still contentious upper stretch then flattened out. CRYPTOQUIP stalked from between rivals but came up empty at the top of the stretch. DANCING BAND, in range between horses, flattened out in the stretch.
