HOLD THAT ECHO, steadied at the start, was rated off the pace, closed late turn, rallied six-wide and swept by in hand. SOUND OF THUNDER raced midpack, closed on the turn, bid a furlong out, was quickly passed but finished best of the rest. FREEMAN'S LASS pulled on the early lead, quickened late turn, was engaged a furlong out and gave way grudgingly. MARIA'S STORY raced midpack, closed five-wide late turn, was contentious upper stretch but flattened out. ANN CAN stalked the pace, closed on the turn then evened out upper stretch. SOAR raced midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. STORMY SHAY raced in midpack early, was hustled on the turn, dropped to last at the top of the stretch then showed no response.
