DO THE MATH stalked the pace from the rail, took command early turn and moved clear then held sway, driving. BEAR'S TIZZ raced in midpack between foes, closed four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. RIOPELLE raced off the early pace, closed between rivals late turn and rallied gamely. BURATINO showed brief speed, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then finished gamely to no avail. TWO OH ONE raced in midpack outside, was hustled five and six-wide on the turn then finished best of the rest. SWIDGEN, off slowly but contentious quickly, was hustled on the turn then evened out in the final furlong. STAMKOS dueled, led late backstretch, was headed early turn, chased to the stretch and tired. JIMMY CHEW SHOOS showed brief speed then settled off the pace, altered course to the outside midway through the turn to avoid a rival in distress, was hustled into the stretch but evened out. CLAYMIESTER, off slowly and off the pace early, bore out through the turn, was checked, then eased in the stretch. DR. CHOPIN had early speed between foes, was headed late backstretch, rebid into the turn but broke down.
