DRINK OR SINK settled off the pace, closed five-wide on the far turn, launched a determined stretch drive and was up just in time. WAKEBOARDER raced in midpack, closed four and five-wide on the far turn, swept to the lead upper stretch then failed to hold the winner safe at the wire. UNWINDING AT WORK raced in midpack, chased three-wide late turn and finished willingly. MIST OPPORTUNITY stalked the pace, offered a strong closing move four-wide on the far turn, gained a short lead, was headed at the top of the stretch and gave way. BISU settled in midpack, closed two to four-wide on the final turn then evened out in deep stretch. STAGE FRIGHT settled off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. BEAR'S MESSAGE, away slowly, settled off the pace, closed into the far turn, chased hard two-wide then evened out in the stretch. FINALLY TOGETHER had early speed, forced the pace on the first turn and backstretch, chased on the far turn then tired. CRYPTOCRAFT had speed, set a pressured pace, was headed late turn and stayed very game into the stretch before tiring. DBL BARREL RESERVE, well back early, was hustled three to six-wide on the far turn then

evened out in the stretch. SEA BANK, in range, chased three and four-wide on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. FLASHOFBRILLIANCE settled off the pace, saved ground but was never in contention. BEIHAI PARK, away slowly, settled well back, closed late on the far turn but lacked a closing response. LOVE TO BATTLE, away slowly, raced off the pace, was hustled two to four-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch.
