SEETHING raced off the pace, closed six-wide late turn, was all out in the stretch and gained command in the final 16th. SPIDER ROCK settled off the pace, was hustled two-wide late turn, chased three-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. BUG'S BOY raced off the pace, was in hand to the top of the stretch, closed six-wide into the stretch, responded smartly and finished under an all out drive. WICKET EWOK stalked the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch, bid a furlong out, took a short lead but failed to stay. FORESTADOR settled off the pace, chased five-wide late turn then rallied belatedly.

NERONE stalked the pace, chased two-wide on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled, then evened out in the late stages. CITIUS, in touch, came three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out with a 16th to run. BEAR'S FUTURE raced in midpack, chased from the rail on the far turn, bid at the top of the stretch, dueled, then flattened out. VEGAS WEEKEND raced off the pace, angled out, chased on the turn but never reached contention. ASCANIA, well back early, was hustled along the rail through the turn but never reached contention. WHISPERED LEGEND set a reserved pace, was hustled on the turn, dueled into the stretch and tired. FAST YANKEE raced off the pace, chased between foes on the turn then tired in the stretch.
