Footnotes

COLONIAL WARMTH showed good early speed and dueled for the early lead, raced three wide on the turn then shook loose in the final furlong under steady pressure. BEAUALLIS pressed the early pace inside of rivals, weakened slightly in the stretch, but held place gamely. OUT WELL was void of early speed, roused between horses on the turn and closed willingly. TORRANTULA was unhurried early off the rail, went four wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. CALEDON COLLEEN was void of early speed, then found her best stride in the drive. DEVILISH LADY was close up between horses then weakened in the stretch. ENIGMATIC bobbled slightly at the start, but recovered quickly and pressed the early pace three wide, then weakened in the stretch. MRS. FISHER was allowed to settle in the three path, made a mild bid on the turn, but was never a threat. MICAYLA'S PEACH was void of early speed and saved ground on the turn to no avail. DEAR TOBIE was void of early speed outside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn.
