Footnotes

EMILYNA broke sharply and raced forwardly outside of rivals, continued four wide on the turn and wore down NORTHBOUND SALLY in the drive getting up in the final strides. The latter split horses in the backstretch and assumed command approaching the far turn, opened a clear lead in upper stretch, finished well but could not hold off the winner. FOXY RED gained a short lead in the early going, then gave way on the turn and dropped back. FRANKNRUSS was unhurried early, roused four wide on the turn, but failed to respond and dropped back. TRICKY MOMENT stalked the early pace and moved to the rail on the turn, but failed to respond and was never a threat. RAJA'S RHYTHM was hustled along pressing the early pace four wide, then tired in the stretch. SPRING GARDEN was slow early inside of rivals and never rallied. EXPLOSIVE AMY showed brief speed between horses, then dropped back on the turn. QUIET THUNDER was void of early speed and never a factor.
