EAGLE POISE settled well off the pacesetter, closed on the far turn alongside EYE OF THE LEOPARD, dueled past the leader late turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead a 16th out and prevailed under a drive. EYE OF THE LEOPARD stalked from far back, closed with EAGLE POISE on the final turn, vied past the pacemaker late turn, dueled through the stretch but was outfinished. SERIOUS INDEED settled off the pace, closed on the third and final turn, was under a drive but could not close the gap in the stretch. HELICOPTER, well back throughout, was hustled on the far turn but never reached contention. COJAC raced off the pace, saved ground, chased into the stretch but was never a threat. PIRATE'S LEGEND, always far back, was hustled on the final turn but lacked a stretch response. HOLY SCHNEIKIES sprinted to a long lead, widened on the backstretch then tired and was passed on the final turn.
