LEINAN settled off the pace, closed on the turn, rallied willingly, bid a 16th out and drove clear. GOLDSTRYKE GLORY settled in midpack, closed steadily late backstretch and through the turn, lapped on to the pacesetter late turn, challenged in earnest at the top of the stretch, took command a furlong out but yielded in the final 16th. MECHAYA came out running and sprinted to a long lead, set the pace, was caught at the top of the stretch and gave way grudgingly. SWEET REDEMPTION off slowly, settled well back, was hustled on the turn, chased along the rail into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. SHENANDOAH LADY broke inward, raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out. LADY BEAR, squeezed back at the start, settled off the pace, was hustled through the turn then tired in the stretch.
