Footnotes

REGAL STAR raced from off the pace, closed three-wide late turn, bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear. THE GOOD LUCK GUY raced midpack, closed between horses late turn and was all out through the stretch. ELVIS THE GREAT showed speed, dueled between rivals, inherited the rail early turn, continued to vie inside BETHUNE then yielded to the winner near the 1/8 pole. BRAVEST APPROVAL, well backed early, closed fast four-wide on the turn but failed to menace. BETHUNE dueled outside rivals, stayed gamely to the stretch but yielded near the 1/8 pole. CRYPTOGRAPHIC stalked from between horses, was roused late turn but evened out. VALID AND BRIGHT dueled early, gave way at the turn and faded. GLENN IS GOLD settled quickly, trailed along the rail, was hustled on the second path late turn and did not threaten. YOUNG DOM was close early, dropped back on the turn and lacked rally. BAJAN PRIDE raced off the pace, came four-wide through the turn and lacked a rally. GONE WILD dueled to the turn then faded along the rail. LATIN AWAD, always far back, came three-wide through the turn then lacked a rally.
