**Footnotes**

QUINNER'S CIRCLE tracked the early leader and was off the rail into the turn, bid outside of that one in the drive, took command then was full out to stave off rivals. MASTER MICHAEL came from mid pack to bid outside in the run to the wire and finished well. PEGASUS PRANCER in touch, gained ground and then bid from the inside in the late going to finish off a good try. VEZEAU BEACH off the pace and off the rail, bid from the six path in the drive and had his best stride late. PEAT BAY up on the pace and tracking the leader while outside of foes, kept contact into the stretch then evened out in the final furlong. GREEN STORM veered in at the break then showed speed to lead in to the turn, was in the hunt into the stretch and still on the engine then tired. ALTONA ROAD off the pace, had no bid and was not a stretch factor. HARD GRAFT settled off the pace and did not fire. BOLT broke awkwardly and appeared to lose and iron, was well back and never close. AGAIN PLEASE in touch briefly and inside, backed away.
