Footnotes

DASHING TOM, prominent early, was headed midway of the backstretch, forced the pace, rebid at the top of the stretch, drove to the lead then held under pressure. OLD BUD stalked the pace, came four to six-wide through the turn and was all out through the stretch. KEVIN RAWKS stalked the pace, angled from three to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished all out. SILKEN MANNER, off a step slowly, raced well back, was hustled along the rail out to four-wide through the turn and finished determinedly. JOEY'S BEST raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn and finished gamely inside, gaining steadily. SHADES OF GOLD forced the pace, took command midbackstretch, set a pressured pace, was engaged at the top of the stretch and yielded grudgingly. FOXLEY raced midpack, closed six-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. CAVALIERDANCER raced midpack, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn and finished well but did not threaten. HOOD POINT was hustled from well back, chased hard late turn but never reached contention. WIDMO raced off the pace, was hustled along but never reached contention.
