TU ENDIE WEI took command moving on to the main track, set a pressured pace, sprinted clear at the top of the stretch and finished under a hand ride. SWEET SEVENTEEN settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. RUNFOR RO settled off the pace, chased four-wide late turn then rallied willingly. PAINTED WOMAN stalked the pace, was hustled into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. ACTIONONTWO, rated off the pace, chased on the turn but never reached contention. MISS SCARLETT ROAD, in touch, was hustled four-wide on the turn then flattened out in midstretch. CASCINA, rated off the pace, chased from the rail on the turn then evened out in the stretch. GALAN'S WINGS forced the

issue, chased along the rail into the stretch and tired. LAS MALVEGAS broke alertly, was headed, pressed the pace, chased into the stretch but tired a furlong out. KITTY'S GOT CLASS, in touch early, settled back on the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. LEXINGTON PEARL raced off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. ESSENCE OF BUBBLES, in midpack early, settled off the pace on the turn, was roused but showed no response.
