Footnotes

SPIDER WIRE broke sharply, but dropped back quickly and was void of early speed well off the rail, roused on the turn while continuing wide, came six wide in the drive and got up in the final strides. B. NILE was allowed to settle outside of rivals, roused five wide on the turn and closed willingly but finished well. VORTICITY stalked the early pace inside of rivals, drew even entering the stretch, then weakened in the late going and jumped a shadow at the wire. CAN YOU FEEL IT was off slowly then rushed to contention between horses and weakened in the drive. KING OF NASTY was allowed to settle inside of rivals, made a mild bid entering the stretch, then flattened out in the late going. PREMIER'S TURN was void of early speed while off the rail, then made a mild bid in the stretch, but was never a threat. UNCLE WOGER showed good early speed close up in the early going, then tired in the drive. LINDROS pressed the early pace four wide between horses, then tired in the stretch. RUSHISCOMINGUP was hustled along between horses, then faded in the stretch.
