Footnotes

HANK'S HILL raced in midpack, chased hard six-wide late turn, rallied and swept by the leader midstretch under a drive. MIA'S MIRACLE stalked the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. TEVEZ settled off the pace, chased between foes on the turn then finished gamely along the rail. GAS N DASH stalked the pace, was hustled between horses on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. KID CANUCK forced the pace, moved to the lead entering the turn, set a pressured pace then shook clear in the stretch, was passed a 16th out and tired. FIRETHEEXECUTIVE, in range, was hustled on the turn, chased three-wide into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. KIRKLAND LAKE bobbed just out, settled off the pace, angled

out late turn and rallied mildly. SHACKLETON HILL set a pressured pace, was headed early turn, forced the issue, chased into the stretch but tired in the late stages. LOVEYOUALLTHETIME bobbled just out, closed to midpack on the backstretch, chased five-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. DEVIL IN WILLIE settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. YOU DON'T PASS, rated off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. MAJOR BRAVO stalked the pace to the turn then faded under a ride and tired.
