Footnotes

UNCLE WOGER broke sharply and dueled in the backstretch, had a clear lead around the turn, widened the advantage in the stretch and was under no encouragement at any point in the race. DANCING DICKIE was allowed to settle well off the rail, rallied 3 wide around the turn, but was no match for the winner. TENGOLDENLEAPS was unhurried early well off the rail, moved to the rail around the turn and finished with a mild rally. EXPLOSIVE MISSION was void of early speed well off the rail, stayed wide around the turn, made a mild bid, but was never a threat. BOLD MAJOR stalked the early pace from the inside, but lacked a late response and dropped back. LAZOR ART was void of early speed, raced between horses around the turn and never rallied. SLIOCH dueled inside of the winner in the backstretch, tired around the turn and faded in the stretch.
