Footnotes

FLORIDA RECOUNT pressed the early pace between horses, dropped back slightly on the second turn, but rallied entering the stretch and assumed command, then drew clear in the final furlong under intermittent urging. BRONZE BAYOU set a pressured pace inside of rivals, opened a clear lead on the second turn, could not hold off the winner, but battled gamely and held place. MERLIN'S MOON was unhurried early while saving ground, then roused on the second turn and finished well. FORD EVERY STREAM was allowed to settle inside of rivals, roused on the second turn and angled to the three path in the drive, but could not close any ground and was never a threat. OCEAN FRONT was slow early and trailed well behind the field, then swung wide on the second turn and rallied belatedly. MARK ONE pressed the early pace three wide, then faded in the stretch. GONE COURTING was unhurried early in the two path and never a factor. MAJESTIC WARLOCK showed little and was outrun.
