HERE COMES CHRISSY, six-wide into the first turn, raced in range, closed with authority on the far turn, bid upper stretch and drove clear. PRIMERIC PRINCE raced off the pace, circled late turn then rallied seven-wide. GLADWYNE, well back early, closed between rivals on the far turn, chased into the stretch, altered course a bit to the outside and finished gamely. MAMMA'S KNIGHT showed brief speed then stalked the pace in hand, chased between foes late turn, hung briefly at the top of the stretch then rallied late. COOL HAND DUKE, five-wide into the first turn, raced off the pace between horses, was five-wide coming into the stretch and rallied late. POACHERS MOON raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the far turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. IT'S A DANZIG took command on the first turn, set a pressured pace, staved off STREET LEGEND on the far turn, was engaged upper

stretch, gave way and tired. CATCH THE LUCK, well back early, was hustled four-wide on the far turn, came eight-wide into the stretch but did not menace. KINGS PARADE raced midpack, was hustled along the rail on the far turn, chased into the stretch and flattened out. TOOK THE TIME, well back early, was roused four-wide on the far turn but lacked a strong response. VESPASIAN, well back early in hand, saved ground but lacked a rally. STREET LEGEND, off a step slowly, raced five-wide into the first turn, forced the pace, failed with a bid into the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired.
