CITY TRIP moved up quickly to take an early lead, set a pressured pace, shook clear on the turn, widened when asked in the stretch and finished under a hand ride. JAZZY ALEXIS raced in midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. CASABLANCA KISS showed brief speed then stalked the pace, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. GOOD VIBRATION raced in midpack, chased late turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. BLONDIE THE BEST, rated off the pace, chased outside rivals late turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch but failed to menace. TINY BEAR raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but lacked a closing response. HOLYANO forced the pace late backstretch, chased hard on the turn then flattened out in deep stretch. PAINTED PONEY showed brief early speed then stalked the pace, chased four-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch.
