**Footnotes**

HIGH JUMPER raced off the pace, circled six-wide late turn, took command midstretch and held under a drive. RIBOT SUN settled off the pace, closed four and five-wide on the far turn, bumped with DRAW A LINE at the top of the stretch, launched his bid but was outkicked. JINX BUSTER raced off the pace, closed along the rail late backstretch, closed on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch and shook clear, was all out but failed to stay in the final 16th. SCARLET'S DIAMOND raced off the pace, chased two-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. WINDANCER'SBOLDONE broke outward and was steadied, raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the far turn but did not threaten. DRAW A LINE showed brief speed then stalked on the backstretch, chased two to four-wide on the turn, bumped with a rival at the top of the stretch then evened out in the late stages. MOBILIST pulled to the lead entering the backstretch, drew off and set the pace, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. GIOLITTI broke in the air, pulled and was steadied behind rivals approaching the first turn, remained in contention then dropped back late turn and lacked a rally. BEAS RIVER DANCER pulled early, stalked on the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn and tired.
