FUTURE STRIKE settled off the pace, closed two-wide on the far turn, had command along the rail at the top of the stretch, drove clear and held sway under a strong hand ride. RED ZEPPELIN raced in midpack, bid four-wide early on the far turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch but finished determinedly. BON JOVI'S SKY, in range, chased hard three to five-wide on the far turn then finished willingly to no avail. A. A. GRENADE settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide late turn then finished gamely in vain. ROSEVILLE dwelt at the start, raced well back of the field, was hustled on the far turn but never reached contention. FLYING ECHO forced the issue, gave way late turn and tired along the rail in the final furlong. BEES BAJAN stalked the pace, chased hard four-wide late turn then tired in the stretch. GATES OF GLORY set a pressured pace, dueled through the far turn and tired at the top of the stretch.
