### Footnotes

GIVE A PRIZE, away slowly, settled off the pace, closed on the backstretch, chased through the turn, rallied between foes in the stretch and was up late under a drive. MISSION SONG led on the main track, set the pace, drew off a bit on the turn, was joined at the top of the stretch, dueled, wore down his rival in the final 16th and was passed. MISS ECHO DURING stalked the pace, chased late turn and finished under a determined drive. SISTERDINI, in range, bid along the rail at the top of the stretch, dueled, but yielded in midstretch. CAVALIERS DESTINY, in range, chased hard on the turn then finished gamely between foes. BUTTERTART, in touch, was hustled late turn and finished evenly. TIMED PERFECTLY, away slowly, settled off the pace, closed outside rivals on the turn but evened out in the stretch. KATYA settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn then lacked a closing response. GLENDAIRY, away slowly, settled off the pace, dropped back on the turn, angled out approaching the stretch but had no response. FLASHY KATIE, in touch between horses, was hustled from the rail on the turn then tired in stretch. DIAMOND GUN led briefly, was headed, backed away late backstretch and faded on the turn.
