EASTERN ATLANTIC led early, set a pressured pace in hand, drew off upper stretch and held sway, driving. ROMAN DAMSEL settled off the pace, chased hard along the rail through the far turn and was all out in the stretch. ANDROEAH raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide on the far turn then finished gamely. COPENHAGEN COWGIRL, away a step slowly, raced off the pace, closed four-wide on the far turn then evened out in deep stretch. CLEMENTIS raced in midpack, closed along the rail on the far turn, chased into the stretch then evened out with a 16th to run. FUTURE SURPRISE stalked the pace, backed away on the far turn, was hustled into the stretch but failed to menace. GALLOPING D'AMOUR settled well back early, was hustled three to five-wide on the far turn but was not a threat. CALIBRATION pressed the pace to the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired.
