**Footnotes**

L'ARGENT led quickly, shook clear entering the main track, set the pace then held REGAL VALLEY safe under a drive. REGAL VALLEY raced off the pace, closed between horses late turn and finished gamely. WESTMORELAND forced the early pace, chased on the turn then evened out late. HIGH VOLT JOLT stalked three-wide, was roused late turn then hung in the stretch. DA CARDINAL raced midpack four-wide, finished evenly. SEEKING THE CARAT raced off the pace, came five-wide through the turn then evened out late. DISBELIEF, outrun early, was roused on the backstretch and showed a mild late run between horses. BLONDE WISDOM, well back along the rail, never reached contention. MY COUSIN MATT, in touch early, was hard ridden on the turn but faded approaching the top of the stretch. ROYAL SLAM forced the issue midway of the backstretch then faded along the rail on the turn. DECEW FALLS was hustled three-wide and tired on the turn.
