PEACH OF A DAY pressed the pace, was hustled seven-wide late turn, bid in the final furlong, gained command and held under a drive. MOLINARO FORT

raced midpack, came six to eight-wide through the turn then rallied gamely and was gaining late. SCRAM DIGGITY raced off the pace, was hustled on the backstretch, chased four-wide on the turn then finished all out late along the inside. ASYMMETRIC dueled early, led into the turn, was headed late turn, rebid upper stretch, led briefly and gave way. NORTHERN MONARCH raced off the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn then rallied between foes. POETIC SOUL raced off the pace, came four to six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. LONE SPRINT raced off the pace, angled five to seven-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then tendered a mild rally. QUEENSBURY RULES, in range early, chased hard three-wide on the turn then finished all out along the rail. RAVEN STONE, in range, closed into the turn, bid late turn, led into the stretch, was headed and gave way. GOLD HILL raced off the pace, came four-wide through the turn but never reached contention. BLONDESSILVERDREAM dueled early, chased five and six-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. TOMAHAWK SELECT raced off the pace, angled two-wide to seven-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. HIS MISTAKE raced midpack five-wide then flattened out in in the final 16th. STORMY MARDEN, in range early, chased along the second-path into the stretch then tired a furlong out.
