ATTICUS APPLE broke inward, settled in midpack, closed angling from the rail to three-wide through the turn, bid a furlong out and drove clear then held under steady pressure. POLITICAL REBEL settled off the pace, closed five-wide late turn, rallied outside and just missed. MIDDLE OF WINTER raced in midpack, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn and was all out through the stretch. ROCK STAR MIA sprinted clear onto the main track, drew off and set the pace, was caught a furlong out and gave way. VICTORY TALISMAN, off alertly, was quickly headed, stalked the pacesetter to the turn, chased two to four-wide then evened out in the stretch. SUTTER'S FIND raced off the pace, chased two-wide late turn but failed to menace. IRATUS LEO raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn, chased gamely through the stretch but was not a threat.
