CONSOLIDATOR JOE forced the pace, bid along the rail late turn, was clear at the top of the stretch and widened, driving. MILWAUKEE MIXER forced the issue, was cleared by the new leader at the top of the stretch then finished gamely and held second. TAPIT'S BREW settled off the pace, was hustled three-wide into the stretch and rallied gamely, but late. WICKET EWOK raced in midpack, chased two-wide late turn and finished all out along the rail. ROB THE CRADLE raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn, finished gamely but did not threaten. EXECUTIVE FIVE was sent to the early lead, set a pressured pace, was headed at the top of the stretch then tired in the final furlong. MOLINARO WARRIOR pressed the pace, chased three to five-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. PENTHOUSE VIEW raced in midpack, dropped back on the turn and lacked a rally.
