BEAR DIXIECAT led into the first turn, set a reserved pace, quickened on the far turn then held, driving. PLEASANT MIX rated early, angled off the rail closing on the turn then was all out gaining in the stretch. PARRSBORO GOLD stalked from the rail, chased on the turn but needed more late. BARONESS angled from the rail to four-wide moving into the far turn, closed, but evened out late. PLEASANT AMELIA rated early, closed into the final turn, chased three-wide then evened out. SAFFI, in touch, chased three-deep on the far turn then lacked a rally. CULPEPER MOON pressed the pace to the far turn then faded between horses.
