**Footnotes**

HIP HIP SINHA off the early pace and inside, angled out, bid from the five path in the drive and was up in time to best the others. JIMMY THE JESTER kept contact while three wide early, tracked the leader into the stretch while off the rail then bid late but was outdone by the winner. WESTON broke tardily and was well back, saved ground while closing then angled to the rail for the final furlong, bid and finished well. NORAM had good speed, opened a gap on the turn then failed to last. STRIKE OR SPARE off the pace had a mild bid between foes to no avail. TURNING TO HOME had an outside trip and was in the five path for the stretch run but lacked the needed kick. AIR HORIZON well back, had a belated outside run but never threatened. LOVIN WAY raced in mid pack and was not a factor. LIQUOR LOGIC chased from between foes then lost ground and tired. BOO BOO'S LOVE was off the pace in a dull try. ELUSIVE SAINT tracked the leader into the turn, was not able to match and faded. WINTER TIRES showed little and finished far back.
