DIAMONDSDIPLOMAT raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the far turn, rallied gamely and took command in the final furlong, driving. BEAR'S TENOR dueled briefly then forced the pace on the backstretch, chased on the far turn, finished determinedly and held the place. WELL READ stalked the pace, closed late backstretch and forced the issue on the far turn, led briefly upper stretch and chased to the end. JOJO'S MOJO dueled earl then stalked the pace on the backstretch, dropped back nearing the far turn, chased to the stretch then evened out in the late stages. BAKERS WOODS dueled, gained a short lead and set a pressured pace on the backstretch and far turn, was headed upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. BATHSHEBA STATION settled off the pace, was hustled two-wide in contention on the far turn then tired in the final furlong.
