Footnotes

AUDREY THERESA, whose saddle slipped early out of the gate, took the lead into the backstretch, set the pace then held sway under light handling. BONARDA settled off the pace, edged closer on the far turn, chased five-wide into the stretch then rallied outside. MY OUT KAST, away alertly, was headed late turn, stalked on the backstretch, chased two-wide to the stretch then yielded the place in the late stages. LOTUS FLOWER, in touch, chased six-wide late turn, launched an all out drive but evened out late. PENNY'S LUCK showed brief speed, dropped back on the backstretch, was hustled on the far turn but was not a threat. ANARUSA, in range four and five-wide throughout, chased on the far turn but tired at the top of the stretch. DADDY'S GINGER showed brief speed, stayed in in touch on the backstretch, chased three and four-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch. I'LL BE HOME SOON settled off the pace, was hustled into the far turn, chased to the stretch but lacked a closing response.
