Footnotes

GOLDEN GIRL SUE took command into the backstretch, set the pace,was joined at the far turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, rebid in the final furlong, drove clear then held under light handling. HOLD THAT ECHO settled off the pace, was hustled five and six-wide on the far turn then finished determinedly between rivals coming in gradually through the stretch. VENUS BAY, away slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled six-wide early turn, angled in to the third path late turn then rallied willingly along the rail. PLAYING FOR FUN forced the early pacesetter in hand, stalked on the backstretch, bid between horses into the far turn, dueled, shook clear at the top of the stretch but was headed in the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. CARRTOWNS KATIE settled off the pace, closed into the far turn, stalked the pace, was roused late turn but flattened out in the stretch. L'AVENUE raced in midpack, chased close up four-wide on the far turn then flattened out midstretch. RIVER SLANEY showed brief speed, was headed entering the backstretch, stalked the pacer, bid into the far turn, dueled from the rail but tired as she approached the top of the stretch.
