FOUR ONE SIX forced the pace, took the lead early turn, was engaged at the head of the stretch, dueled and prevailed under a drive. DON'T TELL ROSIE set a pressured pace, was headed early turn, rebid at the top of the stretch but was outfinished in the duel through the final furlong. CHASE THE UNKNOWN raced in midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then finished gamely. GREEN FORESTER was taken back early, raced off the pace then rallied willingly, but late. FRETO BANDITO, in range, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. ROBADO settled in midpack, chased along the rail on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. PORTOMASO raced off the pace, chased three-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. D'LUCKY CAT, steadied at the start, was used early to gain contention up close to the leaders, fell back on the turn and tired in the stretch.
