TWO OH ONE stalked the pace, challenged late turn, dueled into the stretch, gained a short lead a furlong out and held under a drive. SIR LOWRY'S PASS, off a step slowly, settled well back, closed angling from two to four-wide through the turn then rallied willingly and just missed. THE BULL GOT SHOT set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn, vied into the stretch, was headed a furlong out and gave way grudgingly. CORBELLI raced off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn then finished willingly outside. HAWK'S A BLUR forced the pace, dropped back at the turn, chased in range and finished gamely to the wire. BARBASGO forced the pace, bid along the rail upper stretch but failed to sustain the drive. BOW BELL REEF, in range, chased hard five-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. BOLD ALPIE, in range, was hustled six-wide late turn then evened out in the final 16th. KING TUCKER raced off the pace, was hustled seven-wide late turn but never reached contention. RODEO BOY raced off the pace, came four-wide through the turn and tired in the stretch.
