JUNGLE WAVE pressed the pace, bid into the turn and gained a short lead, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was joined a furlong out, dueled, and prevailed with a strong late effort. BEAR TOUGH TIGER pressed the pace, forced the issue four-wide late turn, bid a furlong out, dueled to the end and just missed. TOP PROSPECT raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide into the stretch then finished gamely in vain. ARROW'S CONQUEST, in range, chased two-wide late turn but evened out in the stretch. SPIDER ROCK raced in midpack, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. SENOR DEHERE (AUS), prominent on the backstretch, gave way early turn, chased to the stretch but lacked a rally. IWILLGOTOTHEMOON raced forwardly, forced the pace three-wide on the turn then tired upper stretch. RACE FOR GOLD, in touch early, chased hard from off the pace on the turn then evened out in the stretch. SANGORE moved up to force the pace nearing the turn but faded quickly under a ride and showed no late response. KIZZY'S CHAOS, rated off the pace, was hustled into the turn, chased two and three-wide then tired nearing the stretch.
