Footnotes

SHEILA'S PROSPECT was allowed to settle outside of rivals and roused four wide on the turn, loomed boldly in the drive and wore down MISS SWEEP under steady pressure. The latter pressed the early pace outside of VICTORY MISS, put that one away in the drive and opened a clear lead, but could not hold off the winner. LIGHTNING PACE was close up between horses in the early going, then roused three wide on the second turn, found her best stride in the late going and closed fast approaching the wire. TACKY AFFAIR was allowed to settle outside of rivals, roused four wide on the turn, but never rallied and was never a threat. VICTORY AT SEA was well rated setting the early pace along the rail, dueled inside of VICTORY MISS on the turn, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. MADAME RED was void of early speed while saving ground and was never a threat. EL PRADO ESSENCE was allowed to settle in the two path and lacked a late response. FEATHERS bobbled slightly at the start, but broke on top, then faded quickly and trailed throughout.
