Footnotes

NEW DILIGENCE stalked the forced pace from the inside, advanced on the turn, gained command into the stretch and drew off. ROSHARON bumped at the start, was close up four wide, finished well to be second best. KNOWN PROSPECT set a pressured pace from off the rail, gave way into the stretch. BORNTOBELOVED had a short lead early, stalked the forced pace four wide, and was not a threat. STUCK IN LIMBO raced three wide, and was not a factor. RED MERCEDES trailed four wide, passed tiring rivals. CAT IN DEED bumped at the start, stalked the forced pace from off the rail, and had no menace. FAR AND NEAR raced off the rail, and showed little. LORD'S KATIE pressed the pace three wide, gave way on the turn, and faded.
