Footnotes

TOP NOTCH LADY rated early, closed four-wide late turn, was under strong encouragement through the stretch and got up late. ANGEL ON WATCH forced the pace from between rivals, kept after GUMBOOTS through the stretch and gained the place in the late stages. GUMBOOTS raced prominently, gained a short lead between rivals late backstretch, remained under pressure on the turn, shook clear upper stretch then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. SUDSY BABY raced just off the pace, moved off the rail late turn to close but needed more response in the stretch. LIKE A GEM forced the pace two deep, dropped in on the rail entering the turn closing off PERIGEE GIRL, chased, but was unable to maintain her best stride. NICELY DONE forced the pace four-wide, bid late turn, yielded upper stretch and tired. PERIGEE GIRL forced the pace from the rail, was closed off entering the turn, was checked and stumbled badly then evened out. TRAIN TO GLORY well back early, was hustled along the rail but was never a factor. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON PERIGEE GIRL AGAINST LIKE A GEM FOR INTERFERENCE EARLY TURN RESULTED IN LIKE A GEM BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED 7TH.
