Footnotes

THOR'S PIPER, bumped at the start, stalked the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the far turn, rallied gamely and was up just in time, driving. MONTANA MEMORIES raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the far turn, was boxed in at the top of the stretch, responded smartly when a path opened and took the lead midstretch, shook clear but failed to stave off the winner in the final strides. JABALI stalked the pace, closed two-wide into the stretch, bid along the rail, was very game but failed to match strides. PRIZED HUMOUR dueled on the backstretch, gained a short lead early turn, was quickly engaged, dueled into the stretch, was headed in the final furlong and chased to the end. EXETER ROAD stalked the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch, launched an all out, drive but weakened in the late stages. PIT ALLEY, bumped at the outset, settled in midpack, closed between foes late backstretch, dueled on the turn, was headed in the final furlong and tired in deep stretch. BIG BREECHES, bumped at the start, was rated off the pace and finished evenly without a serious drive. OJIBWAY SIGNAL raced in midpack, chased five-wide into the stretch then evened out. FUNNY GUY raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide into the stretch then evened out in the late stages. CLEAN HOUSE settled in midpack, was hustled five and six-wide through the far turn but lacked a closing response. CHARLIE'S THE MAN led quickly, dueled on the backstretch, was headed early turn, remained game and up close until backing away late turn and tiring.
