OPENING MEET settled off the pace, closed five-wide late turn, rallied outside and up late, driving. BRITE SABBETH stalked the pace, closed five-wide into the stretch took the lead a furlong out but just failed to hold the winner safe. ONE BIG GATOR raced off the pace, chased late turn, rallied, but evened out in deep stretch. OKIYAMA raced in midpack, chased hard on the far turn then evened out in the late stages. WONDER PHIL led early, forced the pace on the backstretch, bid into the far turn, dueled, led at the top of the stretch but was passed and tired. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM stalked the pace, chased on the far turn then evened out in the late stages. MOBIL UNIT forced the pace, took a short lead on the backstretch, dueled through the turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. NOT TOO TACKY, rated off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. RAYNHAM settled off the pace, was roused late turn but lacked a closing response. KNAVE OF HEARTS, rated off the pace, was hustled hard on the far turn but evened out in the stretch. KING OF THE SWAMP raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide on the far turn then tired in the stretch.
