Footnotes

SMART CHOICE set the early pace in hand four wide, shook loose entering the stretch then held off a persistent DEVIL'S GOOD GIRL under steady pressure. The latter pressed the early pace outside of rivals, dropped back slightly in upper stretch, but rallied in the final furlong and finished well. CHAMUL was hustled along pressing the early pace from the inside, then weakened in the late going. FAR AND NEAR was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused four wide on the turn and finished evenly. GRACEFUL GAL was void of early speed, then roused three wide on the turn and finished with a late gain. YAELLA was unhurried early, then roused between horses on the turn and made a mild bid, but flattened out in the stretch. BAISER D'AMOUR was void of early speed while saving ground and never a threat. SHINE FOR US pressed the early pace between horses, then tired in the stretch. BOLDSEA was void of early speed and never a factor. STEPHANIE'S WAGER was allowed to settle between horses, then dropped back on the turn.
