SUNNY WEATHER, in range, chased four-wide into the stretch, rallied gamely and got by the leader in deep stretch, driving. BEUKABOOM led early, set the pace, was all out in the stretch but failed to contain the winner in the final 70 yards. PROFIT PREFERRED settled off the pace, chased five-wide into the

stretch then rallied gamely outside. TREASURE PIRATE settled off the pace, was hustled late turn then rallied late outside. RAGAMUFFIN, in range early, was hustled late turn, was all out upper stretch but evened out in the late stages. IT'S GOODTOBE DUKE moved outside rivals early on the backstretch, was in touch with the front runners on the turn, chased hard into the stretch but evened out late. KNOWING THE FACT, away slowly, raced off the pace then rallied late outside. BEN'S BEST BET stalked the pace, chased into the stretch, launched an all out drive but tired in the final 16th. MERCY STREET raced in midpack between horses and in striking range late turn, evened out in the stretch. SLEEK AND MOBIL, away slowly, raced off the pace, saved ground and finished gamely in vain. RULING SILENCE, well back early, was hustled on the turn then rallied late between horses. MEGAS VICTOR settled off the pace, saved ground, was game to midstretch and evened out. FORESTERS PRIDE stalked the pace, chased between horses on the turn but backed away nearing the stretch. CUTTING WIT raced in midpack from the outside and faded late turn.
