Footnotes

ASCOT'S LEGEND raced midpack between horses, closed five-wide late turn, rallied and got up late, driving. FULL OF WISDOM set a pressured pace, turned back MAPLE TINTS at the top of the stretch but failed to contain the winner on the late stages. PIRATE'S LEGEND, in range outside, stalked three-wide on the turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch and finished determinedly. GREAT IT TIZ, off a step slowly, raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn and rallied outside. SAY NO EVIL had brief speed, forced the issue, bid late turn, vied into the stretch then gave way grudgingly. HANDY HAROLD showed brief speed, settled on the first turn, stalked the pace from between rivals then flattened out in the final furlong. MAPLE TINTS stalked from the rail, closed late turn, bid at the top of the stretch but could not match strides and tired. SIR ADIE, in range, was hustled four-wide on the far turn, came six-wide into the stretch then lacked a response. SEPTEMBER SQUARE raced off the pace, was hustled from the fifth path to seven-wide late turn, was lugging in a bit and tired.
