**Footnotes**

TSUNAMI SURREAL broke outward, was well-placed in touch with the leader, bid midturn, led into the stretch and held sway under a drive. IDENTITY THEFT, away alertly, settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn, closed into the stretch and finished all out. MIDNIGHT RAWKS settled off the pace, chased late turn then rallied late outside. RAGING RIVER settled in midpack, was hustled late turn, chased through the stretch but evened out late. EARLY RINGALING raced in midpack, closed four-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. HAGGAT HALL raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. JEST HUSH settled off the pace, trailed the field, chased on the far turn but failed to menace. COVE ISLAND LIGHT stalked the pace, chased two to five-wide on the far turn but lacked a closing response. SMART AND FLASHY was used early to gain the lead, sprinted clear and set the pace, was passed midturn, chased to the stretch and tired.
