VINTAGE RED pressed the early pace inside of rivals, assumed command in upper stretch and drew clear under steady pressure. EXPLOSIVE AMY was well rated inside of rivals, raced three wide on the turn and was blocked in upper stretch, angled to the outside in the final furlong and rallied belatedly. ADAGIO'S GEM stalked the early pace outside of rivals and ran evenly. BARBAREES HILL was unhurried early while saving ground, slipped through entering the stretch, but flattened out in the drive. TRICKY MOMENT was void of early speed and never a factor. CAUGHT FIRE vied for the early lead between horses, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. ROMAN ROMANCE set a pressured pace three wide, then got tired in upper stretch and dropped back.
