APRES MIDI, rated off the pace, closed along the rail late turn, rallied, took command under a drive early in the final furlong then was taken well in hand. BRAIN POWER led quickly, set the pace, was hustled on the turn, was caught then headed just into the final furlong but easily held the place. CUVARA stalked the pace, chased late turn and was all out through the stretch. HA LONG BAY settled off the pace, chased four-wide on the turn, finished determinedly but did not threaten. THORNWOOD ROAD raced off the pace, chased from midturn but failed to menace. TOP THE PODIUM stalked the pace in the early going then dropped back a little, was hustled along the second path on the far turn but did not threaten. C. C. RIDE stalked the pace, chased along the rail late turn but evened out in deep stretch. STRIKE OIL raced in midpack, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong.
