GOLD LEAF ROSE raced off the pace, was hustled from the rail to three-wide from midturn, rallied gamely and just got up. SPLASH OF GOLD was hustled to contention on the backstretch, bid into the turn and moved clear quickly, had command to near the wire and faltered. EVENING GLITTER stalked from the rail, chased on the turn and was all out in the stretch. XPECTTHEUNEXPECTED, in touch early, was hustled on the turn then hung in the stretch. FLEET KRIS, well back early, was roused at the top of the stretch but did not threaten. SNEAKY STORM led quickly, was headed early turn, chased briefly then tired.
