WAKE AT NOON was well rated just off the lead, drew even three wide on the turn and dueled outside of PRAISE FROM DIXIE briefly in the drive, then drew clear in the final furlong under intermittent urging. The latter sprinted to the early lead from the inside, held a short advantage to the drive, but was no match for the winner. GOLDEN RETURNS was hustled along pressing the early pace between horses, then weakened in the drive. OPUS WON was void of early speed along the rail and never a factor. INDIAN TROUBLE showed no speed while racing off the rail.
